

my cup is overflowing.

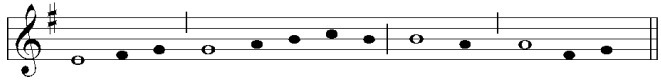
Surely goodness and kindness shall follow me

things in heaven and things on earth.

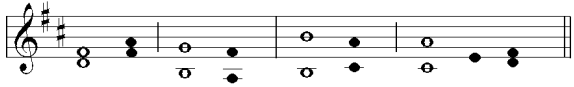

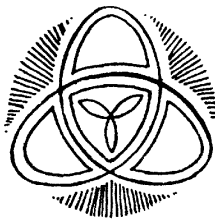
